WEBINAR ON "PROJECT FINANCING"



CEAI Eastern & North Eastern Region organised a webinar on "*Project Financing*" on 8th August 2023. The presentation was made by Mr Subhendu Moitra who has over 33 years of leadership experience across Infrastructure Finance/ Advisory, Investment Banking, Project Finance, Resolution of Stressed Assets, Government Advisory, M&A, and Development Banking, across sectors. He is currently an Independent Advisor and Founder Director of M/S Coeus Advisors Pvt Ltd., an Investment Banking Advisory company.

He explained that Project Finance is a non-recourse method of financing projects. It is an attractive financing alternative enabling project sponsors to shed risk to the other stakeholders and thus allows the sponsors to develop other projects and become serial developers. Therefore, the knowledge of risks and structures of project finance to handle risk is paramount in achieving the best structure from a financier's perspective.





Project finance has a certain uniqueness vis-à-vis the traditional corporate finance – projects with large investments, longer maturity, and above all non-recourse or limited recourse to the sponsors. It is the most effective method of funding large infrastructure projects.

Project finance become popular when economic development took center-stage in developed countries and subsequently in the developing countries, where huge capital was required. More and more private developers with expertise in project execution became developers and were short of capital. The capital required for development of a large projects could only be generated through project finance. Further, with infrastructure projects being funded through PPP structure, which are projects with no tangible assets, the traditional asset-based financing has been replaced by project financing, which depends more on future cash flow and assignment of rights, as primary security, as against the tangible project assets in conventional lending for projects.

In India, with last few decades of liberalization the Government has invited private sector developers for development of large projects, especially in the infrastructure sectors. That also necessitated project finance by lenders, for such large projects with huge debt requirements. Subsequently with increased overall growth in economy in the last decade, the investments in such projects increased further. The sudden increase in demand and the use of project finance route to finance such large requirement of debt for such projects has necessitated requirement of understanding of risk of such projects, measuring those risks and suggest appropriate built-in mitigation measures for countering the adverse effects of such risks, for the lenders as also other stakeholders.

After the successful run of the Soft Skill Training on 26th and 31st July 2023, CEAI Academy organised another on *"Be A Constructive Leader"* for engineers of M/s Consulting Engineers Group Ltd. on 20th August 2023 at Jaipur.
